Kilteely Dromkeen GAA Club has a very long and historic association with the GAA. The first team affiliated by Kilteely was in 1887 and by Dromkeen in 1898. The day club of Kilteely Dromkeen was formed in 1971.

Currently the club plays hurling and football in the East Division and caters for players from six years upwards, which includes 10 juvenile teams. The high points have been the winning of county junior hurling championship in 1972 and the county junior football championship in 1989 as well as competing in U21 football county finals in the late 1990's.

We are having great success at juvenile level, claiming many east championships from U12 to U16. Last year we competed in four county semi finals U-14, U-16 hurling and football. Our primary schools in Kilteely and Cloverfield have had excellent successes, winning out their respective divisions on many occasions.

The club has a very strong tradition in all Scor competitions and especially in the Novelty Act, winning two senior All-Ireland titles in 1978 and 1986 and two Scor na nOg All-Ireland titles in 2002 and 2003.

The club is no stranger to hosting the Feile. We were delighted to host visitors in 1973, 1984, 1994 & 2005. In 2005 we hosted Brussels and in 2006 we made the trip to Brussels at the invitation of the Brussels club and enjoyed an action filled weekend.
